Section 387-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 387-2, the 3 "(a) 4 director [may], by rule, may provide for the employment[+ Of learners, of apprentices, of part-time 5 (1)employees who are full-time students attending public 6 or private schools other than colleges, universities, 7 business schools, or technical schools, and of wards 8 paroled from the Hawaii youth correctional facility, 9 under special certificates issued by the director, at 10 [such] wages lower than the applicable minimum wage 11 and subject to [such] limitations as to time, number, 12 proportion, and length of service [as] that the 13 14 director [shall prescribe; and] prescribe. 15 [(2) Of individuals whose earning capacity is impaired by 16 old age or physical or mental deficiency or injury, 17 under special certificates issued by the director, at
