A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§291- Designation of parking spaces for electric
- 5 vehicles; spaces available to general public. Each parking
- 6 space, in places of public accommodation available for use by
- 7 the general public, that is designated exclusively for electric
- 8 vehicles and equipped with an electric vehicle charging system
- 9 shall be counted as four parking spaces toward the total number
- 10 of parking spaces available for use by the general public as
- 11 required by applicable city and county regulations."
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 "§291-71 Designation of parking spaces for electric
- 15 vehicles; charging system. (a) Places of public accommodation
- 16 with at least one hundred parking spaces available for use by
- 17 the general public shall have at least one parking space

•	exclusively for electric venicles and equipped with an electric
2	vehicle charging system located anywhere in the parking
3	structure or lot [by July 1, 2012]; provided that no parking
4	space designated for electric vehicles shall displace or reduce
5	accessible stalls required by the Americans with Disabilities
6	Act Accessibility Guidelines. Spaces shall be designated,
7	clearly marked, and the exclusive designation enforced. [Owners
8	of multiple parking facilities within the State may designate
9	and electrify fewer parking spaces than required in one or more
10	of their owned properties; provided that the scheduled
11	requirement is met for the total number of aggregate spaces on
12	all of their owned properties.]
13	(b) The department of transportation shall provide written
14	notification of noncompliance to an owner of a place of public
15	accommodation if the department believes that the place of
16	public accommodation is not compliant with this section,
17	pursuant to the following procedures:
18	(1) Within three hundred sixty-five days after the owner's
19	receipt of a notification of noncompliance, the
20	department of transportation shall provide the owner

1		of the place of public accommodation with a first	
2		warning of noncompliance with this section;	
3	(2)	Within one hundred eighty days after provision of a	
4		first warning of noncompliance, the department of	
5		transportation shall provide the owner of the place of	
6		public accommodation with a formal notice of violation	
7		of this section; and	
8	(3)	Within ninety days after provision of a formal notice	
9		of violation of this section, if the violation	
10		persists, the department of transportation shall fine	
11		the owner of the place of public accommodation as	
12		provided in subsection (c).	
13	<u>(c)</u>	The department of transportation shall fine an owner	
14	of a plac	e of public accommodation that is in violation of this	
15	section \$	for every day that the place of accommodation	
16	remains in violation after receipt of the formal notice of		
17	violation. If a fine against a place of public accommodation		
18	accrues t	o more than \$, then the department of	
19	transportation shall place a lien against the real property of		
20	the place	of public accommodation.	

1	(d)	The department of transportation may exempt a place of
2	public ac	commodation from compliance with this section in cases
3	of financ	ial or engineering hardship; provided that a financial
4	hardship	exemption shall not be granted for a place of public
5	accommoda	tion if electrical charging stations can be installed
6	at no cos	<u>t.</u>
7	[-(b)	(e) For the purposes of this section:
8	"Ele	ctric vehicle" means:
9	(1)	A neighborhood electric vehicle as defined in section
10		286-2; or
11	(2)	A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws
12		propulsion energy from a battery with at least four
13		kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be
14		recharged from an external source of electricity.
15	"Ele	ctric vehicle charging system" means a system that:
16	(1)	Is capable of providing electricity from a non-vehicle
17		source to charge the batteries of one or more electric
18		vehicles;
19	(2)	Meets recognized standards, including standard SAE
20		J1772 of SAE International; and

1	(3)	Is designed and installed in compliance with article
2		625 of the National Electrical Code

- 3 "Place of public accommodation" has the same meaning as
- 4 [that provided] in section 489-2[-]; provided that the term
- 5 shall not include parks, campsites, trailer facilities, or other
- 6 recreational facilities."
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 9 begun before its effective date.
- 10 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Electric Vehicles; Parking Spaces; Fines

Description:

Provides that each parking space designated for an electric vehicle shall count as four parking spaces available for public use towards any city or county requirements regarding number of total public use parking spaces. Establishes notification requirements and fines for noncompliance.

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
