- SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an

- 5 SECTION 2. Article II of the Constitution of the State of
- 6 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
- 7 designated and to read as follows:
- 8 "RECOUNT OF ELECTION VOTES
- 9 Section . A recount of votes cast in an election may be
- 10 conducted in such manner as shall be provided by law."
- 11 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 12 be as follows:
- "Shall a recount of votes cast in an election be allowed to
- 14 be conducted in such manner as shall be provided by law?"
- 15 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.

- 1 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
- 2 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
- 3 the State of Hawaii.
