A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 489J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "<u>§489J-</u> <u>Electronic receipts.</u> (a) Each proof of
- 5 purchase for the retail sale of tangible personal property or
- 6 for the provision of services in this State to a member of a
- 7 frequent shopping program may be provided only in electronic
- 8 form, unless the member requests that the proof of purchase be
- 9 provided in paper form.
- (b) As used in this section:
- 11 "Frequent shopper program" means a program that rewards
- 12 customers for purchases made on multiple visits and builds up
- 13 points entitling them to reduced prices, free items, or other
- 14 incentives.
- "Member" means a member of a frequent shopper program."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on April 25, 2112.
