# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SINGLE-USE PLASTIC STRAWS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 339, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§339- Single-use plastic straws; prohibited acts. (a)
5	<u>A full-service restaurant shall not provide a single-use plastic</u>
6	straw to a consumer unless requested by the consumer.
7	(b) Any full-service restaurant who violates this section
8	shall be issued a notice of violation by the director for the
9	first and second violations. For any subsequent violation, a
10	full-service restaurant shall be subject to a fine imposed by
11	the director of \$25 per day of violation, not to exceed \$300
12	during any calendar year. Any action taken to impose or collect
13	the fines provided for in this section shall be considered an
14	administrative action pursuant to chapter 91.
15	(c) For purposes of this section:
16	"Consumer" means a person who is a member of the public,
17	takes possession of food or beverages, is not functioning in the

3	<u>"Ful</u>	l-service restaurant" means an establishment with the

7	(1)	The consumer is escorted or assigned to an assigned
8		eating area. The employee may choose the assigned

14	(3)	The food and beverage orders are delivered directly to
