### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SERVICE IN NON-CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to convene a task
force in the judiciary to review amending the procedure for the
giving of notice or service of legal process in civil and
administrative proceedings by allowing documents to be served
upon parties by electronic mail.

6 SECTION 2. (a) There is established within the judiciary, 7 for administrative purposes, a temporary task force that shall 8 discuss, review, and seek input on amending the procedure for 9 the giving of notice or service of legal process in civil 10 proceedings in the district, circuit, and family courts and in 11 administrative proceedings by allowing documents to be served 12 upon parties by electronic mail.

- 13 (b) The task force shall consist of:
- 14 (1) One representative from the judiciary, who shall serve15 as chair of the task force;
- 16 (2) One representative chosen by the president of the 17 senate;
