## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part XII to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§291C- Display of registration tags or emblems and
- 5 inspection stickers. No person shall operate a vehicle
- 6 registered and inspected in the State pursuant to chapters 249
- 7 and 286 unless the vehicle displays a current, valid
- 8 registration tag or emblem that is affixed in the manner
- 9 prescribed by section 249-7(c) and a current, valid inspection
- 10 sticker that is affixed in the manner prescribed by section 286-
- 11 26(e). A law enforcement officer may issue a citation to any
- 12 person who operates a vehicle in violation of this section;
- 13 provided that the penalty for a violation of this section shall
- 14 be as prescribed in section 286-25 or section 286-61, as
- 15 applicable."

# $H.B.\ NO.\ ^{788}_{H.D.\ 2}$

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect any rights and duties
- 2 that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that
- 3 were begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

### Report Title:

Statewide Traffic Code; Citation; Missing Registration Tag or Emblem, or Safety Inspection Sticker

Authorizes a law enforcement officer to cite any person who operates a motor vehicle that does not display a current, valid vehicle registration tag or emblem and a current, valid safety inspection sticker as prescribed by statute. (HB788 HD2)
