

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECTS IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the entitlement
- 2 process for affordable housing projects in community development
- 3 districts needs to be clearer. When a county or state project
- 4 is being developed in a community development district, the
- 5 developers must formally consult with the Hawaii community
- 6 development authority. However, the statute does not explicitly
- 7 require similar consultation by developers with the authority
- 8 for an affordable housing development in a community development
- 9 district. Greater transparency will be achieved if developers
- 10 must consult with the authority when building affordable housing
- 11 projects in community development districts.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to clarify the entitlement
- 13 process for affordable housing projects developed pursuant to
- 14 section 201H-38, Hawaii Revised Statutes, within a community
- 15 development district by requiring developers to consult with the
- 16 Hawaii community development authority.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 206E-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+] §206E-13[+] Public and affordable housing projects.
- 4 Any project or activity of any county [or], agency of the State,
- 5 or eligible housing project developed pursuant to section 201H-
- 6 38 in a designated district shall be constructed, renovated, or
- 7 improved in consultation with the authority."
- 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
