A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The taxation rebalancing and repurposing 2 task force is established within the department of taxation for 3 administrative purposes only. The task force shall study the 4 need to rebalance and repurpose the tax programs under the 5 State's general excise tax law, income tax law, and transient 6 accommodations tax law. Specifically, the task force shall 7 consider opportunities to make the administration of these 8 programs more effective and efficient so that the programs are 9 reallocated and realigned to:

10 (1) Respond to the needs and desires of the residents in
11 the State;

- 12 (2) Minimize the duplication and redundancy of state13 resources;
- 14 (3) Ensure that tax revenues are used for the programs15 that generated them; and

1	(4)	Lower the state tax burden on businesses and residents
2		while ensuring that quality government services are
3		provided to residents of the State and visitors.
4	(b)	The task force shall consist of the following members:
5	(1)	The governor or the governor's designee, who shall
6		serve as chairperson;
7	(2)	The mayor of each county or the respective mayor's
8		designee;
9	(3)	The speaker of the house of representatives or the
10		speaker's designee; and
11	(4)	The president of the senate or the president's
12		designee.
13	(c)	Members of the task force shall be exempt from section
14	26-34, Ha	waii Revised Statutes, and members shall serve without
15	compensat	ion, but shall be reimbursed for reasonable expenses
16	necessary	for the performance of their duties, including travel
17	expenses.	
18	(d)	The task force shall submit a report of its findings
19	and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the	
20	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of	
21	the regul	ar session of 2020.
