RELATING TO TRAFFIC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part XII to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§291C- Bicycle and motor scooter traffic prohibited;
- 5 state capitol area. No person shall operate a bicycle or motor
- 6 scooter within the state capitol area, specifically the
- 7 pedestrian mall running East-West between Richards Street and
- 8 Punchbowl Street that abuts the Hawaii state capitol building,
- 9 Iolani Palace, and the main branch of the Hawaii state library,
- 10 and upon which there has been erected a statute to honor Queen
- 11 Liliuokalani."
- 12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
