A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAND AND BUILDING ACQUISITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that article XI, section
- 2 3 of the state constitution requires the State to "conserve and
- 3 protect agricultural lands, promote diversified agriculture,
- 4 increase agricultural self-sufficiency and assure the
- 5 availability of agriculturally suitable lands".
- 6 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 7 funds for the purchase of land that will help fulfill the
- 8 State's constitutional duty to strengthen the agricultural
- 9 sector.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 14 2020-2021 to acquire the property identified as tax map key
- 15 number (1)9-2-001:011-0000; provided that the price does not
- 16 exceed the amount appropriated.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the agribusiness
- 2 development corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
