A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM JURY DUTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that due to the critical 2 roles that physicians, members of the armed forces, police, 3 firefighters, and emergency medical service members play in 4 ensuring the safety of the public welfare in emergency 5 situations, those individuals are currently exempt from jury 6 duty pursuant to section 612-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The legislature also finds that, pursuant to chapter 127A, Hawaii 7 8 Revised Statutes, the Hawaii emergency management agency and the 9 county emergency management agencies serve essential, critical, 10 and unique roles and functions in providing emergency management 11 services in the State. The legislature further finds that it is 12 important to eliminate any hindrances that active members of 13 those agencies may face in serving in their roles.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to exempt from jury duty any active member of the Hawaii emergency management agency or any county emergency management agency.
