## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require that new income tax credits include a five-year sunset or a gradual 2 reduction that will force the legislature to review the 3 necessity and advisability of continuing the tax credit. 4 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately 6 7 designated and to read as follows: 8 Tax credits; generally. Beginning January 1, 2020, any income tax credit established under this chapter shall 9 10 include either: 11 (1) A five-year sunset date; or 12 (2) Beginning with the sixth year of the credit, a one-13 third annual reduction in the credit amount allowed to 14 be claimed, over a three-year period, which shall trigger legislative review and determination of 15 16 whether an extension is advisable or necessary." **17** SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
