A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM STATE BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS
2	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish the
3	operating budget for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019,
4	and ending June 30, 2021, for state executive branch programs
5	under the purview of the house of representatives standing
6	committee on water, land, and Hawaiian affairs.
7	SECTION 2. Unless otherwise clear from the context, as
8	used in this Act:
9	"Expending agency" means the department of business,
10	economic development, and tourism.
11	Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or
12	a house of representatives standing committee, shall mean the
13	following:
14	BED Department of business, economic development, and
15	tourism

- 1 "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which
- 2 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the
- 3 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations
- 4 are followed by letter symbols. The letter symbols, where used,
- 5 shall have the following meanings:
- 6 A General funds
- 7 B Special funds
- 8 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent
- 9 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a
- 10 particular program during a specified period or periods, as
- 11 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent
- 12 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent
- 13 positions.
- 14 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific
- 15 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization
- 16 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the
- 17 organization number for the program.

18 PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS

- 19 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
- 20 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
- 21 herein, are hereby appropriated or authorized, as the case may

- 1 be, from the means of financing specified to the expending
- 2 agency designated for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1,
- 3 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures and the
- 4 number of positions in each fiscal year of the biennium shall
- 5 not exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
- 6 fiscal year, except as provided elsewhere in this Act or as
- 7 provided by general law.

1 PART III. MISCELLANEOUS AND EFFECTIVE DATE

- 2 SECTION 4. If any portion of this Act or its application
- 3 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for
- 4 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of
- 5 this Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be
- 6 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
- 7 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
- 8 be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the
- 9 extent possible.
- 10 SECTION 5. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
- 11 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may
- 12 correct the errors.
- 13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
