BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The office of planning shall conduct a
2	study on	the state of the infrastructure of the Banyan Drive
3	area on t	he Waiakea Peninsula of the island of Hawaii.
4	(b)	The study shall include, without limitation, a
5	comprehensive review of the following:	
6	(1)	The current condition of the infrastructure of the
7		Banyan Drive area;
8	(2)	Items that are in current need of repair, improvement
9		modification, or alteration;
10	(3)	The barriers that hinder or prevent the timely
11		redevelopment, enhancement, or reconstruction of the
12		Banyan Drive area; and
13	(4)	Recommendations regarding repairs, improvements,
14		modifications, or alterations to reduce or eliminate
15		the barriers to the possible redevelopment,
16		enhancement, or reconstruction of the Banyan Drive
17		area.

- 3 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 4 to the convening of the regular session of 2020.
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 8 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 9 2020-2021 for the purposes of this Act.
