The attorney general, on behalf of the 1 department of education, shall acquire or take the property 2 3 described in section 1 of this Act in its existing condition, and shall provide for the indemnification of the Mililani Town 4 5 Association for all claims and liabilities against the Mililani 6 Town Association that may arise concerning the physical, 7 environmental, soil, economic, and legal conditions of the 8 property, from the effective date of this Act until the 9 voluntary action or the condemnation process is complete. 10 SECTION 3.
