A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS SAFETY ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding to part I a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§28- Issuance of credentials pursuant to the Federal
- 5 Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act, as amended. The attorney
- 6 general may issue credentials to qualified law enforcement
- 7 officers, pursuant to the federal Law Enforcement Officers
- 8 Safety Act of 2004 (Public Law 108-277), codified at 18 U.S.C.
- 9 section 926C, as amended. The attorney general may adopt,
- 10 amend, and repeal rules, without regard to the requirements of
- 11 chapter 91, for the issuance of the credentials."
- 12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
