

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND UNITED STATES NAVY TO RENEW FUNDING FOR THE KANEOHE WAVE ENERGY TEST SITE.

WHEREAS, wave energy technology uses the surge of the ocean 1 to generate clean, free, and endlessly renewable electrical 2 3 power; and 4 WHEREAS, wave energy has the potential to add a unique and 5 consistent resource to Hawaii's renewable energy portfolio, 6 helping to achieve the State's goal of one hundred percent 7 renewable energy by 2045; and 8 9 WHEREAS, in 2012, the United States Department of Energy 10 and United States Navy selected Hawaii through a competitive 11 process to be one of two Wave Energy Test Sites (WETS) in the 12 United States; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, the wave energy test site in Kaneohe Bay, on the island of Oahu, was designed to test the commercial viability of 16 wave energy devices and to determine whether the technology 17 18 could successfully supply energy to a power grid; and 19 WHEREAS, in July 2015, a prototype wave generator called 20 Azura became the first wave technology device to successfully 21 supply grid power, producing twenty kilowatts of clean energy 22 23 for the State of Hawaii; and 24 25 WHEREAS, although research is ongoing, federal funding for 26 the Wave Energy Test Site at Kaneohe Bay is scheduled to expire 27 in 2022; and -28



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WHEREAS, further funding is needed to perfect wave energy 1 technology, develop a permitting process, and support a public-2 private partnership to grow the industry; now, therefore, 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by House of Representatives of the Thirtieth 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the 6 Senate concurring, that the Legislature recognizes the critical 7 8 importance of wave energy technology to the State's renewable energy goals and urges the United States Department of Energy 9 and United States Navy to renew their funding of the Kaneohe 10 11 Wave Energy Test Site; and 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Secretary of Energy, 14 Secretary of the Navy, and President of the University of 15 Hawaii. 16 17 18 19
