HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A WORKING GROUP TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF BUILDING AN ADDITIONAL WORK FURLOUGH CENTER ON THE PRESENT SITE OF THE OAHU COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER ONCE THE OAHU COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER HAS BEEN RELOCATED TO HALAWA.

1 WHEREAS, the Laumaka Work Furlough Center is a part of the 2 Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) in urban Honolulu, and 3 houses inmates who are either actively seeking employment or 4 working in the community, as a means to ease their transition 5 upon release; and

7 WHEREAS, the Laumaka Work Furlough Center is located at 6478 Laumaka Street, about one block away from OCCC; and

10 WHEREAS, the Laumaka Work Furlough Center has space for 11 ninety-six inmates; and

13 WHEREAS, twice that number of inmates are eligible for the 14 work furlough program; and

16 WHEREAS, plans for the new OCCC on the site of the existing 17 animal quarantine center in Halawa Valley call for the Laumaka 18 Work Furlough Center to remain in Kalihi, with a separate 19 structure planned as part of the new OCCC to accommodate the 20 remaining number of eligible work furlough inmates; and

22 WHEREAS, the Laumaka Work Furlough Center's location in 23 Kalihi affords easy access to public transportation and work 24 places for inmates in the work furlough program, and is 25 therefore preferable to the more remote Halawa site; and

27 WHEREAS, with the relocation of OCCC to Halawa, the28 existing site will be available to be repurposed and could serve



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as an adjunct to the neighboring Laumaka Work Furlough Center; 1 2 and 3 4 WHEREAS, there are many examples of ex-offender programs 5 contributing to the vitality of their communities, including the Delancey Street Foundation in San Francisco, California, 6 7 reflecting the positive influence these programs can have on inmates transitioning back to larger communities and the 8 9 communities themselves; now, therefore, 10 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 11 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 12 13 2020, the Senate concurring, that a working group is requested 14 to be established to study the feasibility of building an additional work furlough center on the present site of the Oahu 15 Community Correctional Center once it has been relocated to 16 17 Halawa; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested to consist of the following members: 20 21 22 (1)A member appointed by the Director of Public Safety; 23 24 (2) A member of the Honolulu City Council appointed by the 25 Council Chair; 26 27 (3) A representative of the Hawaii Correctional System Oversight Commission designated by the Chairperson of 28 **29** · the Commission; 30 (4) A member appointed by the Kalihi-Palama Neighborhood 31 32 Board; and 33 A representative of the Kalihi Business Association; 34 (5) 35 with the chairperson of the working group to be selected by the 36 working group; and 37 38 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, 40 including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later 41



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than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session 1 2 of 2021; and 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group dissolve on 4 5 June 30, 2021; and 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Director 8 of Public Safety, Chair of the Honolulu City Council, 9 Chairperson of the Hawaii Correctional System Oversight 10 Commission, Chair of the Kalihi-Palama Neighborhood Board, and 11 Co-Presidents of the Kalihi Business Association. 12 13 14 OFFERED BY: 15
