HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE COUNTIES TO DEVELOP PROCEDURES TO ACCEPT DONATIONS OF CERTAIN LANDS.

WHEREAS, private lands in the State have sustained damage 1 2 due to flooding, hurricanes, volcanic eruptions, and other natural disasters, and lands along the coastlines will 3 inevitably be lost to the effects of climate change; and 4 5 WHEREAS, lava disasters in 1990 and 2018 have destroyed 6 7 towns and villages on the Big Island while Waikiki and other coastal areas will face infrastructure challenges against an 8 9 encroaching sea; and 10 WHEREAS, the State and counties need to develop innovative 11 disaster loss mitigation strategies in order to limit the future 12 costs to the State and counties due to disasters that befall 13 landowners who have built their homes in flood areas and lava 14 15 zones; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Legislature believes that the counties are 18 important partners in developing and implementing disaster loss mitigation strategies for the benefit of the public; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, the counties and owners of land likely to be damaged by disasters or flooding would benefit from procedures 22 for the acceptance of private land as donations for which the 23 donor would receive a nonrefundable charitable income tax 24 deduction; now, therefore, 25 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 28 29 2020, that the counties are requested to develop procedures to accept donations of private lands that are damaged or likely to 30 sustain damage due to natural disasters or climate change; and 31 32
