### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 333F-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending the definition of "developmental
3	disabilit	ies" to read as follows:
4	" "De	velopmental disabilities" means a severe, chronic
5	disabilit	y of a person which:
6	(1)	Is attributable to a mental or physical impairment or
7		combination of mental and physical impairments;
8	(2)	Is manifested before the person attains age twenty-
9		two;
10	(3)	Is likely to continue indefinitely;
11	(4)	Results in substantial functional limitations in three
12		or more of the following areas of major life activity:
13		self-care, receptive and expressive language,
14		learning, mobility, self-direction, capacity for
15		independent living, and economic sufficiency; and
16	(5)	Reflects the person's need for a combination and
17		sequence of special, interdisciplinary, or generic

1	care, treatment, or other services that are of		
2	lifelong or extended duration and are individually		
3	planned and coordinated.		
4	An individual from birth to age nine who has a substantial		
5	developmental delay or specific congenital or acquired condition		
6	may be considered to have a developmental disability without		
7	meeting three or more of the criteria described above, if the		
8	individual, without services and supports, has a high		
9	probability of meeting those criteria later in life. <u>Eligible</u>		
10	conditions shall include cerebral palsy or epilepsy, autism		
11	spectrum disorder, fetal alcohol spectrum disorder, or a		
12	disorder due to a neurological condition, central nervous system		
13	disorder, or chromosomal disorder that results in both		
14	substantial impairment of general intellectual functioning and		
15	adaptive behavior skill deficits similar to those of a person		
16	with an intellectual disability."		
17	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.		
18	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
