16		to a maximum of one hundred dollars per one-way
17		segment going to or from court; provided that a

1	receipt for the taxi or other hired car service fare
2	is submitted prior to reimbursement.
3	A person who appears at the time for which that person is
4	summoned to court for jury duty may be allowed the [mileage_fee
5	or bus fare] transportation reimbursement although the person,
6	upon that person's request, is subsequently excused or exempted
7	from jury service.
8	(b) In the discretion of the court, any juror who incurs
9	additional expenses for transportation, board, and lodging as a
10	result of the distance the juror resides from the location of
11	the court, may be reimbursed for actual expenses."
12	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
