BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 205-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

Conservation districts shall include areas necessary 3 "(e) 4 for protecting watersheds and water sources; preserving scenic **5** ' and historic areas; providing park lands, wilderness, and beach 6 reserves; conserving indigenous or endemic plants, fish, and 7 wildlife, including those which are threatened or endangered; 8 preventing floods and soil erosion; forestry; open space areas 9 whose existing openness, natural condition, or present state of 10 use, if retained, would enhance the present or potential value of abutting or surrounding communities, or would maintain or 11 12 enhance the conservation of natural or scenic resources; areas 13 of value for recreational purposes; other related activities; 14 and other permitted uses not detrimental to a multiple use 15 conservation concept. Any wireless communication antenna, as 16 defined in section 205-4.5(a)(18), located within the

conservation district shall be camouflaged to blend in with the
