RELATING TO HAWAII STATE AND CONTRACTED CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to re	ad as follows:

5	center de	aths; reporting. (a) Within forty-eight hours, the
6	director	shall report to the governor, and the governor shall
7	report to	the legislature, the death of any:
8	(1)	Correctional facility or community correctional center
9		employee who dies on the grounds of a correctional
10		facility or community correctional center where Hawaii
11		inmates reside or who sustains an injury on the
12		grounds of a correctional facility or community
13		correctional center where Hawaii inmates reside that
14		causes the death of the employee; and
15	(2)	Hawaii inmate who is incarcerated in a state or
16		contracted correctional facility.

1	(b)	The report in subsection (a) shall include the					
2	following	information:					
3	(1)	The name of the decedent;					
4	(2)	The gender and age of the decedent;					
5	(3)	Whether the decedent was an inmate or an employee;					
6	(4)	The location of the death or injury leading to the					
7		death;					
8	<u>(5)</u>	The date and time of the death;					
9	(6)	The cause of death; and					
10	<u>(7)</u>	A report of the clinical mortality review conducted in					
11		response to the death, including correctional actions					
12		to be taken;					
13	provided t	that when the official cause of death has been					
14	determine	d, the director shall immediately report the official					
15	cause of o	death to the governor, and the governor shall					
16	immediately report the official cause of death to the						
17	legislature.						
18	<u>(c)</u>	The director shall have the discretion to withhold					
19	disclosure	e of the decedent's name pending notification of the					
20	death to	the next of kin or if the decedent's identity is					
21	protected	from disclosure by state or federal laws."

#### Report Title:

Correctional Facilities Deaths; Reporting Requirements

#### Description:

Requires the Director of Public Safety, in the event of any death of an inmate who is in a state or contracted correctional facility or correctional facility or community correctional center employee, to provide a report to the Governor and Legislature with certain information regarding the death. Authorizes Director to withhold disclosure of decedent's name under specific conditions.

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
