## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 249-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending the definition of "bicycle" to read as		
3	follows:		
4	""Bicycle" means [ <del>every</del> ] <u>:</u>		
5	<u>(1)</u>	$\underline{\mathtt{A}}$ device propelled solely by human power upon which	
6		any person may ride, having two tandem wheels sixteen	
7		inches in diameter or greater, and including any	
8		device generally recognized as a bicycle though	
9		equipped with two front or two rear wheels[+]; or	
10	(2)	A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title	
11		15 United States Code section 2085; provided that an	
12		operator of a low-speed electric bicycle shall be at	
13		least fifteen years of age."	
14	SECTION 2. Section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
15	amended by amending the definition of "bicycle" to read as		
16	follows:		
17	""Bicycle" means [ <del>every</del> ]:		

1	<u>(1)</u>	$\underline{\underline{A}}$ device propelled solely by human power upon which	
2		any person may ride, having two tandem wheels sixtee	
3		inches in diameter or greater, and including any	
4		device generally recognized as a bicycle though	
5		equipped with two front or two rear wheels[+]; or	
6	(2)	A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title	
7		15 United States Code section 2085; provided that an	
8		operator of a low-speed electric bicycle shall be at	
9		least fifteen years of age."	
10	SECTION 3. Section 291C-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
11	amended b	y amending the definition of "bicycle" to read as	
12	follows:		
13	""Bicycle" means [every]:		
14	(1)	$\underline{\mathtt{A}}$ vehicle propelled solely by human power upon which	
15		any person may ride, having two tandem wheels, and	
16		including any vehicle generally recognized as a	
17		bicycle though equipped with two front or two rear	
18		wheels except a toy bicycle[-]; or	
19	(2)	A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title	
20		15 United States Code section 2085; provided that an	

- operator of a low-speed electric bicycle shall be at

  least fifteen years of age."

  SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that

  matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
  begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
