## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FOURTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$71,299,000 or so much  
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020  
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
fourteenth senatorial district, as follows:

1. Moanalua gardens foundation

Design for restoring and realigning a  
portion of Kamananui valley road.

shall be expended by the department of accounting and general  
services.

equipment for a roof to protect

20 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
21 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at



1 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
2 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
3 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
