## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE VEHICLE WEIGHT TAX.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 249-6.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3	"[ <del>[</del> ]§249-6.5[ <del>]</del> ] Exemption for National Guard, military
4	reserves, and other active duty military personnel [claiming
5	Hawaii as their residence of record]. (a) One noncommercial
6	motor vehicle registered to a member of the National Guard,
7	military reserve, or armed service, including the Coast Guard,
8	who is:
9	(1) Assigned to a unit in the State; and
10	(2) A member in good standing,
11	shall be exempt from the vehicle weight tax provided for in this
12	chapter.
13	(b) One noncommercial motor vehicle registered to a member
14	of the National Guard, military reserve, or armed service,
15	including the Coast Guard, who:
16	(1) Is assigned to a unit outside of the State;

17 (2) Is a member in good standing; and



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(3) Claims Hawaii as the member's state of legal residence
for purposes of withholding state income taxes from
the member's military pay,
shall be exempt from the vehicle weight tax provided for in this
chapter."
SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
