A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
2	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
3	as follows:
4	"CHAPTER
5	AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVOCATE
6	§ -1 Affordable housing advocate office; qualifications;
7	duties. (a) There is established the office of the affordable
8	housing advocate, to be placed within the office of the
9	governor, which shall be headed by the affordable housing
10	advocate. The affordable housing advocate shall be appointed,
11	without regard to section 26-34, by the governor to serve a term
12	of four years concurrent with the term of the governor.
13	(b) The person appointed as the affordable housing
14	advocate shall be experienced in affordable housing issues and
15	development, United States Department of Housing and Urban
16	Development programs and regulations, interpretation of state

1	and feder	al laws and rules, arbitration and negotiation, and	
2	investigation.		
3	(c)	The affordable housing advocate shall:	
4	(1)	Work with all state agencies that manage land to solve	
5		the housing shortage, with attention given to the	
6		needs of Hawaii's non-homeowner residents for	
7		assistance to reach the stability of homeownership or	
8		long-term secure rentals;	
9	(2)	Monitor, comment, and report on the State's production	
10		of affordable housing units, the development and	
11		implementation of federal, state, and local laws,	
12		applicable federal regulations, affordable housing	
13		policies, and actions that pertain to affordable	
14		housing, and shall recommend changes as necessary;	
15	(3)	Seek administrative, legal, or other remedies to carry	
16		out this chapter; and	
17	(4)	Carry out all other responsibilities as provided by	
18		state or federal law."	
19	SECT	ION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
