## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM JURY DUTY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that due to the critical SECTION 1. 2 roles that physicians, members of the armed forces, police, 3 firefighters, and emergency medical service members play in 4 ensuring the safety of the public welfare in emergency 5 situations, those individuals are currently exempt from jury 6 duty pursuant to section 612-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The 7 legislature also finds that, pursuant to chapter 127A, Hawaii 8 Revised Statutes, the Hawaii emergency management agency and 9 county emergency management agencies serve essential, critical, 10 and unique roles and functions in order to provide emergency 11 management for the State. The legislature therefore finds that 12 it is important that active members of those agencies face no 13 hindrances in serving in their roles. However, under current 14 law, active members of emergency management agencies are not 15 exempt from jury duty.

16 The purpose of this Act is to facilitate the implementation
17 of the policy and purpose of chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised



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1 Statutes, by exempting active members of the Hawaii emergency 2 management agency and county emergency management agencies from 3 jury duty. SECTION 2. Section 612-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 5 amended to read as follows: 6 "§612-6 Exempt when. (a) A person may claim exemption 7 from service as a juror if the person is: 8 An elected official while the legislature is in (1)9 session, or a judge of the United States, State, or 10 county; 11 (2)An actively practicing physician or dentist; 12 (3) A member of the armed forces or militia when on active 13 service and deployed out-of-state; 14 An active member of a police or fire department; (4)15 (5) A person who has served as a juror, either in a court of this State or the United States District Court for 16 17 the District of Hawaii, within one year preceding the time of filling out the juror qualification form; 18 19 (6) An active member of an emergency medical services 20 agency;
