7		developer's promotional plan for the project are in
8		compliance with all applicable state and county land
9		use laws and with chapter 205, including section
10		205-4.6 where applicable;
11	(2)	Whether the structures and uses anticipated by the
12		developer's promotional plan for the project are in
13		compliance with all applicable county real property
14		tax laws, and the penalties for noncompliance; [and]
15	(3)	A declaration, subject to the penalties set forth in
16		section 514B-69(b), that the project plan was
17		disclosed to the respective community association or

1		neighborhood board or equivalent organization at least
2		sixty days prior to registration;
3	(4)	A declaration, subject to the penalties set forth in
4		section 514B-69(b), that the developer offered to, or
5		conducted, a presentation disclosing the project plan
6		to the neighborhood board or equivalent organization
7		at least sixty days prior to registration; and
8	[(3)]	(5) Other disclosures and information that the
9		commission may require."

Agricultural Condominium Property Regimes; Public Disclosure; Developer's Public Report

Description:

Requires developers of condominium projects in the agricultural district to declare in their public report that the project plan was disclosed and that the developer offered to, or conducted, a presentation disclosing the project plan to the respective community association or neighborhood board at least sixty days prior to registration of the project.

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
