A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FISHING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that night scuba
- 2 spearfishing could potentially deplete the ocean of aquatic
- 3 life, which is necessary for the preservation of Hawaii's ocean
- 4 environment and coral reefs. Most fish sleep at night and are
- 5 easy prey to scuba spearfishers. Many night scuba spearfishers
- 6 target larger fish, which subsequently reduces the mean size of
- 7 species left to be fished. This is a concern because the larger
- 8 fish lay more eggs, and the offspring of larger female fish are
- 9 healthier and have a better chance of survival than the
- 10 offspring of younger, smaller fish. Selective size-based
- 11 fishing is concerning to fishery managers because as mean fish
- 12 size decreases, reproductive output declines exponentially.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to protect the State's
- 14 environment, aquatic species, and fishing stocks by prohibiting
- 15 scuba spearfishing at night.

- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 188, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§188- Scuba spearfishing at night; prohibition. (a)
- 5 It is unlawful to conduct scuba spearfishing at night in state
- 6 marine waters for the purpose of taking aquatic life, except
- 7 under the terms and conditions of a permit first obtained by the
- 8 user from the department. The department may issue permits for
- 9 nighttime scuba spearfishing consistent with other legal
- 10 requirements.
- 11 (b) The department may revoke any permit for any
- 12 infraction of the terms and conditions of the permit. Any
- 13 person whose permit has been revoked shall not be eligible to
- 14 apply for another permit until the expiration of one year from
- 15 the date of revocation.
- 16 (c) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 17 91 necessary for the purposes of this section, including
- 18 enforcement of and exemptions to this section."
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 20 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 21 begun before its effective date.

SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on December 31,

2050.
