A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that as the demand for
- 2 unskilled labor increases, farmers and ranchers continue to
- 3 search for alternative ways to operate their farms using new
- 4 technology, such as small equipment tractors from Japan.
- 5 However, according to the United States Environmental Protection
- 6 Agency, small equipment engines from foreign countries like
- 7 Japan do not comply with the Environmental Protection Agency's
- 8 standard emissions regulations for small engines.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 10 department of agriculture for a pilot program to identify and
- 11 purchase efficient foreign agriculture small equipment and
- 12 retrofit engines to comply with the Environmental Protection
- 13 Agency's standard emissions regulations for small engines.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 to
- 17 establish a pilot program to identify and purchase the outer

- 1 shell of efficient foreign agriculture small equipment and
- 2 retrofit engines to comply with Environmental Protection Agency
- 3 emissions standards for small engines.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. The chairperson of the board of agriculture
- 7 shall submit a report to the legislature on the pilot program's
- 8 progress and any findings, recommendations, or proposed
- 9 legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 10 the regular session of 2020.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
