BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. This Act responds to the Office of the 1 2 Auditor's Report No. 14-16, Audit of the Department of Health's Glass Advance Disposal Fee Program, specifically recommendation 3 4 number 1.a.: The Department of Health should work with the Legislature to update the State's waste disposal goals to ensure 5 6 the goals are measurable and revised when necessary. The 7 proposed amendments are consistent with the Aloha+ Challenge target of reducing total solid waste prior to disposal by 8 9 seventy per cent by 2030.

10 SECTION 2. Section 342G-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended as follows:

12 "[+]§342G-3[+] Goals. (a) It is the goal of the State to 13 reduce [the] total solid waste [stream] prior to landfill 14 disposal by[+

15 (1) Twenty five per cent by January 1, 1995; and 16 (2) Fifty per cent by January 1, 2000;

seventy per cent through source reduction, recycling, and 1 2 bioconversion [-] by 2030. Where feasible, the office shall 3 establish other state goals for specific commodities, recognizing market considerations. 4 [(b) It is the goal of the State to reduce by not less 5 than twenty-five per-cent the amount of office paper generated 6 7 by all state and county agencies by January 1, 1995, through source-reduction. The base-year for calculating-progress toward 8 this goal shall be total office paper consumption by state and 9 10 county agencies in 1990. 11 (c)] (b) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to 12 restrict a county from setting waste reduction goals higher than 13 those of the State." SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 17
