## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL GOALS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act responds to the Office of the
- 2 Auditor's Report No. 14-16, Audit of the Department of Health's
- 3 Glass Advance Disposal Fee Program, specifically recommendation
- 4 number 1.a.: The Department of Health should work with the
- 5 Legislature to update the State's waste disposal goals to ensure
- 6 the goals are measurable and revised when necessary. The
- 7 proposed amendments are consistent with the Aloha+ Challenge
- 8 target of reducing total solid waste prior to disposal by
- 9 seventy per cent by 2030.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 342G-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- "[+] §342G-3[+] Goals. (a) It is the goal of the State to
- 13 reduce [the] total solid waste [stream] prior to disposal by [+
- 14 (1) Twenty five per cent by January 1, 1995; and
- 15 (2) Fifty per cent by January 1, 2000;
- 16 through source reduction, recycling, and bioconversion.] any
- 17 means, including but not limited to landfill, incineration,



- 1 waste-to-energy, or recycling, by seventy per cent by 2030.
- 2 Where feasible, the office shall establish other state goals for
- 3 specific commodities, recognizing market considerations.
- 4 [(b) It is the goal of the State to reduce by not less
- 5 than twenty five per cent the amount of office paper generated
- 6 by all state and county agencies by January 1, 1995, through
- 7 source reduction. The base year for calculating progress toward
- 8 this goal shall be total office paper consumption by state and
- 9 county agencies in 1990.
- 10 (c) (b) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to
- 11 restrict a county from setting waste reduction goals higher than
- 12 those of the State."
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
