BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the 2 mandatory inscription on civil identification cards by deleting 3 the words "STATE OF" in front of the words "HAWAII 4 IDENTIFICATION CARD" in section 286-305(a), Hawaii Revised 5 Statutes. 6 SECTION 2. Section 286-305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 8 "(a) Each identification card issued by the examiner of 9 drivers shall display a distinguishing number assigned to the 10 cardholder, and shall display the following inscription: 11 "[STATE OF] HAWAII IDENTIFICATION CARD"" 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 13 and stricken.
