RELATING TO TEACHER HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§201H- Housing voucher program; full-time teachers.
5	(a) The corporation may develop and implement a housing voucher
6	program for full-time teachers employed by the department of
7	education or at a public charter school. Each housing voucher
8	shall not exceed \$500 and may be used toward rent or mortgage
9	payments for the teacher's primary residence.
10	(b) Upon the establishment of any housing voucher program
11	for full-time teachers, the corporation shall develop an
12	application procedure, as well as processes, procedures, and
13	forms necessary to implement and maintain the housing voucher
14	program. The corporation shall also work with the department of
15	education and state public charter school commission to develop
16	a process to verify an applicant's status as a full-time teacher
17	employed by the department of education or at a charter school.

1	(c) Any housing voucher granted pursuant to this section
2	shall be renewable without further application or verification.
3	(d) The corporation may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
4	to effectuate the purpose of this section."
5	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
