BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-624, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) The salary schedule for all teachers of the
4	department shall be negotiated pursuant to section 89-9[$-$];
5	provided that:
6	(1) For a certified teacher who has completed a
7	state-approved teacher education program, the starting
8	salary shall be no less than \$55,000 a year; and
9	(2) For a certified teacher who has completed a
10	state-approved teacher education program and earned a
11	master's degree from an accredited teacher education
12	program, the starting salary shall be no less than
13	\$60,000 a year."
14	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16	begun before its effective date.
