A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that an increasing amount
- 2 of government contracts require the use of computers, a virtual
- 3 office, or online activity. The legislature further finds that
- 4 there is difficulty in verifying hours worked on computers for
- 5 government contracts. The purpose of this Act is to establish a
- 6 secure and transparent process to verify hours worked on
- 7 computers for government contracts to prevent abuse and
- 8 overbilling.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 11 and to read as follows:
- 12 "§103D- Automatic verification software. (a) This
- 13 section shall apply only to a contract by or on behalf of any
- 14 governmental body of the State for professional or technical
- 15 services in excess of \$100,000.
- (b) A contract subject to this section shall require a
- 17 contractor to use software to verify that hours billed for work

14	(3)	Provide to the governmental body or the auditor
15		automated real-time cost status of each task;
16	(4)	Provide to the governmental body professional
17		biographical information;
18	(5)	Protect all private or confidential data pertaining to
19		individuals pursuant to applicable state and federal
20		law; and

1	(6) Permit the governmental body to provide immediate		
2	feedback to the contractor on work in progress.		
3	(c) The data collected by the software shall be considered		
4	accounting records belonging to the contractor. The contractor		
5	shall store, or contract with another to store, the data		
6	collected by the software for a period of seven years and		
7	provide access to the contracting governmental body or state		
8	auditor upon request.		
9	(d) The contractor shall not charge the governmental body		
10	or the auditor for access to or use of the work verification		
11	software, or for access to or retrievals of data collected by		
12	the software.		
13	(e) Software used under this section shall be procured by		
14	the contractor from an independent entity."		
15	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
