## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WEED AND SEED STRATEGY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the weed and seed
strategy is a United States Department of Justice initiative
that is administered locally by the United States Attorney's
Office.

5 The weed and seed strategy is a collaborative effort among 6 federal, state, and county law enforcement agencies, social 7 service agencies, private businesses, nonprofit organizations, 8 and residents to reclaim, restore, and rebuild communities. The 9 four key elements of the weed and seed strategy are:

- 10 (1) Law enforcement;
- 11 (2) Community policing;

12 (3) Prevention, intervention, and treatment programs; and13 (4) Neighborhood restoration.

14 The weed and seed strategy uses local law enforcement to 15 prevent, control, and reduce violent crime, drug abuse, and gang 16 activity in targeted neighborhoods by "weeding" out the criminal 17 element in the community. Community policing involves having

police officers work closely with community residents to develop solutions to violent and drug-related crimes. The next step is to "seed" the community with human services that include prevention, intervention, treatment, and neighborhood revitalization.

6 The legislature finds that the weed and seed program has 7 been successful since its inception in the Kalihi-Palama and 8 Chinatown areas of downtown Honolulu as well as in Waipahu, Ewa, 9 and Ewa Beach. The legislature also finds that crime in these 10 areas has been significantly reduced since the inception of the 11 program.

12 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to13 maintain the weed and seed strategy.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$400,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Weed and Seed Hawaii, Inc., to maintain the weed and seed program.
