A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION OF BALLOTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 15-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) If absentee ballots requested under section 15-4 are 4 not received by a voter within five days of an election, if a 5 voter requires a replacement ballot within five days of an 6 election, or if a voter would otherwise not be able to return a 7 properly issued ballot by the close of polls, then a voter may 8 request that absentee ballots be forwarded by electronic 9 transmission [-]; provided that a voter with special needs may 10 request that a ballot be forwarded by electronic transmission at 11 any time. Upon receipt of such a request and confirmation that 12 proper application was made, the clerk may transmit appropriate 13 ballots, together with a form requiring the affirmations and 14 information required by section 15-6, and a form containing a 15 waiver of the right to secrecy, as provided by section 11-137. 16 The voter may return the voted ballots and executed forms by 17 electronic transmission or mail; provided that they are received

1 by the issuing clerk no later than the close of polls on 2 election day. Upon receipt, the clerk shall verify compliance 3 with the requirements of section 15-9(c) and prepare the ballots 4 for counting pursuant to section 15-10; provided that if the 5 voter returns multiple voted absentee ballots for the same 6 election, the clerk shall, for purposes of counting ballots, prepare only the first absentee ballot returned that is not 7 8 spoiled."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
