Section 46-16.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows: 3 "(f) Each county with a population equal to or less than 4 five hundred thousand that adopts a county surcharge on state 5 tax ordinance pursuant to this section shall use the surcharges received from the State for: 6 7 (1)Operating or capital costs of public transportation 8 within each county for public transportation systems, 9 including public roadways or highways, public buses, 10 trains, ferries, pedestrian paths or sidewalks, or bicycle paths; [and] 11 12 Expenses in complying with the Americans with (2) 13 Disabilities Act of 1990 with respect to paragraph 14 (1)[-];15 (3) Infrastructure; 16 (4) Public safety; and
