A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST E OLA MAU NA LEO O KEKAHA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that E Ola Mau Na Leo O
- 2 Kekaha proposes to obtain, remediate, and develop the old Kekaha
- 3 Sugar Mill from Kekaha MS, LLC, in Kekaha, Kauai, Hawaii, to
- 4 create, among other things, a smart farming enterprise, tourist
- 5 and cultural center, community sunshine market, community
- 6 greenhouse, and community manufacturing and incubator facility.
- 7 Acquiring, remediating, and developing the property to provide
- 8 various services will address community and island-wide issues
- 9 relating to the preservation of a historic cultural site,
- 10 preservation of important agricultural endeavors, and
- 11 development and creation of diverse economic drivers on the west
- 12 side of Kauai that have significantly diminished in recent years
- 13 due to the closing of the Kekaha Sugar Mill.
- 14 The legislature additionally finds and declares that the
- 15 proposed acquisition, remediation, and development of the Kekaha
- 16 Sugar Mill through the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds



- 1 under this Act is in the public interest and will further public
- 2 health, safety, and general welfare.
- 3 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part III, IV, or V, or a
- 4 combination thereof as the progress of the project may
- 5 determine, of chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the
- 6 department of budget and finance, with the approval of the
- 7 governor, is authorized to issue special purpose revenue bonds
- 8 in a total amount not to exceed \$10,000, in one or more series,
- 9 for the purpose of assisting E Ola Mau Na Leo O Kekaha, a Hawaii
- 10 domestic 501(c)(3) entity, in acquiring, remediating, and
- 11 developing the aforementioned project. The legislature hereby
- 12 finds and determines that E Ola Mau Na Leo O Kekaha's financing,
- 13 acquisition, remediation, construction, and development of this
- 14 project constitutes projects as defined in part III, IV, or V,
- 15 or a combination thereof as the progress of the project may
- 16 determine, of chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the
- 17 financing thereof will provide assistance to a manufacturing,
- 18 processing, or industrial enterprise, or a combination thereof
- 19 as the progress of the project may determine.
- 20 SECTION 3. The special purpose revenue bonds and the
- 21 refunding special purpose revenue bonds issued under this Act



- 1 shall be issued pursuant to part III, IV, or V, or a combination
- 2 thereof as the progress of the project may determine, of chapter
- 3 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to the power to issue
- 4 special purpose revenue bonds to assist manufacturing,
- 5 processing, or industrial enterprises, or a combination thereof
- 6 as the progress of the project may determine.
- 7 SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is
- 8 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to
- 9 June 30, 2024, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in
- 10 whatever principal amounts the department shall determine to be
- 11 necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized
- 12 in section 2 and to refund special purpose revenue bonds
- 13 authorized in this section, regardless of whether the
- 14 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special
- 15 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of
- 16 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue
- 17 bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in
- 18 section 2. In making this determination, the department shall
- 19 comply with federal law relating to the exemption from federal
- 20 income taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature
- 21 authorized by this section.

- 2 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on June 30, 2024.
- 3 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
