## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCIENCE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that as an outgrowth of
- 2 the immense investment in scientific research initiated by the
- 3 United States during World War II, the national laboratories
- 4 have served as the leading institutions for scientific
- 5 innovation in the United States for more than seventy years.
- 6 The United States Department of Energy's seventeen national
- 7 laboratories tackle the critical scientific challenges of our
- 8 time, from combating climate change to discovering the origins
- 9 of our universe, and possess unique instruments and facilities,
- 10 many of which are found nowhere else in the world. They address
- 11 large scale, complex research and development challenges with a
- 12 multidisciplinary approach that places an emphasis on
- 13 translating basic science to innovation.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to direct the governor to enter
- 15 into negotiations with the United States Department of Energy to
- 16 establish a national laboratory in Hawaii.



- 1 SECTION 2. (a) The governor shall enter into negotiations
- 2 with the United States Department of Energy to establish a
- 3 national laboratory in Hawaii.
- 4 (b) No later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 5 the regular sessions of 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024, the
- 6 governor shall submit a report to the legislature on the status
- 7 of the negotiations to establish a national laboratory in Hawaii
- 8 and the terms of an agreement, if any.
- 9 (c) Any agreement to establish a national laboratory in
- 10 Hawaii entered into pursuant to this Act shall be subject to
- 11 legislative approval.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2100.
