BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Unless otherwise clear from the context, as
used in this Act:
"Capital project number" means the official number of the
capital project, as assigned by the responsible organization.
"Expending agency" means the executive department,
independent commission, bureau, office, board, or other

9 political subdivisions of the State, or any quasi-public

10 institution supported in whole or in part by state funds, which

11 is authorized to expend specified appropriations made by this

9 SECTION 2. The sums of money appropriated or authorized in 10 this Act for capital improvements shall be expended for the projects listed below. Accounting of the appropriations by the 11 12 department of accounting and general services shall be based on 13 the projects as such projects are listed in this section. 14 Several related or similar projects may be combined into a 15 single project if such combination is advantageous or convenient 16 for implementation; provided that the total cost of the projects 17 thus combined shall not exceed the total of the sum specified 18 for the projects separately. The amount after each cost element 19 and the total funding for each project listed in this part are 20 in thousands of dollars.
