# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATED TO BAIL HEARINGS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 804, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§804- Right to a prompt hearing. (a) Upon formal		
5	charge and detention, and upon motion by either party, the		
6	defendant shall have a right to a prompt hearing concerning the		
7	defendant's release or detention and whether any condition or		
8	combination of conditions will reasonably assure the defendant's		
9	appearance as required.		
10	(b) At the hearing, the judge shall consider the following		
11	factors in making a decision concerning release or detention:		
12	(1) If there is a serious risk that the defendant will		
13	<pre>flee;</pre>		
14	(2) If there is a serious risk that the defendant will		
15	obstruct or attempt to obstruct justice, or injure or		
16	intimidate, or attempt to injure or intimidate, a		
17	prospective witness or juror;

1	(3)	If there is a serious risk that the defendant poses a	
2		danger to any person or to the community; or	
3	(4)	If there is a serious risk that the defendant will	
4		engage in criminal activity.	
5	(c)	At the hearing, the defendant shall have the right to	
6	be repres	ented by counsel, and, if financially unable to obtain	
7	represent	ation, to have counsel appointed. The defendant shall	
8	be afford	ed an opportunity to testify, to present witnesses, to	
9	cross-examine witnesses who appear at the hearing, and to		
10	present information by proffer or otherwise. The rules		
11	concerning admissibility of evidence in criminal trials shall		
12	not apply	to the presentation and consideration of information	
13	at the he	aring. The defendant may be detained pending	
14	completio	on of the hearing."	
15	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
16	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
17	begun bef	ore its effective date.

19	SECT	TION 4. This Act shall take effect on March 15, 2094.
