BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 134, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§134- Possession of a loaded firearm while intoxicated		
5	prohibited.	(a) It shall be unlawful for a person to possess a	
6	loaded firearm while the person is intoxicated.		
7	(b) An	y person violating this section shall be guilty of a	
8	petty misdemeanor.		
9	(c) Fo	r purposes of this section:	
10	<u>(1)</u> A	person is in possession of a loaded firearm when the	
11	pe	rson has immediate physical control over a loaded	
12	<u>fi</u>	rearm and the person is outside of the person's	
13	dw	elling as defined in section 703-300; and	
14	(2) <u>A</u>	person is intoxicated if the person:	
15	<u>(A</u>) Is under the influence of alcohol in an amount	
16		sufficient to impair the person's normal mental

2		careful and prudent manner;
3	<u>(B)</u>	Has .08 or more grams of alcohol per two hundred
4		ten liters of the person's breath; or
5	<u>(C)</u>	Has .08 or more grams of alcohol per one hundred
6		milliliters or cubic centimeters of the person's
7		blood."
8	SECTION 2	. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
9	matured, penal	ties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
10	begun before i	ts effective date.
11	SECTION 3	. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 4	. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
