### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 103D-1002, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
"(d) Where a bid or proposal contains both Hawaii and non Hawaii products, then for the purpose of selecting the lowest

5 bid or purchase price only, the price or bid offered for a

6 Hawaii product item shall be decreased by subtracting [ten]

7 twenty per cent for class I Hawaii product items bid or offered,

8 or [fifteen] twenty-five per cent for class II Hawaii product

9 items bid or offered. The lowest total bid or proposal, taking10 the preference into consideration, shall be awarded the contract

11 unless the bid or offer provides for additional award criteria.

12 The contract amount of any contract awarded, however, shall be 13 the amount of the bid or price offered, exclusive of the

14 preferences."

15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 17 begun before its effective date.
