BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Act 127, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is
2	amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:
3	"SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
4	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$59,616 or so much
5	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
6	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
7	2020-2021 for the one permanent full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)
8	position of Alzheimer's disease and related dementia services
9	coordinator within the executive office on aging.
10	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the executive
11	office on aging for the purposes of this Act."

13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
