RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-340, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) Subsection (b) notwithstanding, if a candidate
- 4 committee does not file the [second] preliminary primary report,
- 5 due ten calendar days before a primary, initial special, or
- 6 initial nonpartisan election, or the preliminary general report,
- 7 due ten calendar days before a general, subsequent special, or
- 8 subsequent nonpartisan election, or if a noncandidate committee
- 9 does not file the preliminary primary report or the second
- 10 preliminary general report by the due date, the fine, if
- 11 assessed, shall not exceed \$300 per day; provided that, in
- 12 aggregate:
- 13 (1) The fine shall not exceed twenty-five per cent of the
- 14 total amount of contributions or expenditures,
- whichever is greater, for the period covered by the
- 16 report; and
- 17 (2) The minimum fine, if assessed, shall be \$300."
