BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 11-364, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

 "(a) Any candidate, candidate committee, or noncandidate

 committee that receives in the aggregate more than the
- 5 applicable contribution limit in section 11-357, 11-358, 11-359,
- 6 [or] 11-360, or 11-362 shall return any excess contribution to
- 7 the contributor within thirty days of receipt of the excess
- $oldsymbol{8}$ contribution. Any excess contribution not returned to the
- 9 contributor within thirty days shall escheat to the Hawaii
- 10 election campaign fund."
- 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
